

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
PRINCESS CHULABHORN'S COLLEGE, SATUN AND
FURUKAWA REIMEI JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

Introduction:

Princess Chulabhorn's College, Satun and Furukawa Reimei Junior and Senior High School have come to an understanding that is outlined in this memorandum. This memorandum is based on three principles.

Friendly Relations: A desire to enhance friendly relations between the two schools by cultivating strong ties.

Global Educational Co-operation: A desire to improve and acknowledge the importance of global educational co-operation and cultivation of ties between the two schools for mutual benefit.

Exchange of Ideas: A desire to share scientific ideas, cultures and teaching methods, believing that such an exchange of ideas would benefit both schools.

THE SCHOOLS HAVE REACHED THE FOLLOWING UNDERSTANDING:

1. Objective

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to clarify our desire to share scientific ideas, cultures and teaching methods and improve the relationship between the two schools through co-operation in the field of education.

2. Areas of Co-operation

For the purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding, each party shall endeavor to:

- 2.1 establish exchange programs for students;
- 2.2 develop potential exchange activities for school leaders and teachers; and
- 2.3 collaborate in teaching and learning of specific subject areas.

3. Establish Exchange Programs for Students

- 3.1 Both schools will encourage students to exchange their ideas and knowledge on their science projects through the Internet and Skype communication;
- 3.2 Both schools will send students to participate in various types of exchange programs, which may include opportunities to immerse in language, culture, arts, sports and co-curricular activities during the school vacations; and

3.3 Both schools will assist in organizing the activities and local logistical arrangements for the visiting groups. Logistical arrangements do not include financial areas. Specific logistical and budgetary considerations should be discussed in detail for each proposed exchange.

4. Develop Exchange Activities for School Leaders and Teachers

Both schools have agreed to explore potential opportunities for sharing and collaborating in areas such as curriculum and teaching methodologies and materials through educational visits and professional short-term teaching attachments for school leaders and teachers.

5. Collaborate in Teaching and Learning of Specific Subject Areas

Both schools have agreed to collaborate and share teaching strategies to improve the teaching and learning of sciences, mathematics and technology.

6. Compliance with the Law


This Memorandum of Understanding shall be implemented in accordance with the applicable laws, regulations and national policies of both parties and their home nations.

7. Amendment and Termination Provisions

- 7.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall take effect upon signature of both parties and will remain effective for four years after the signing date;
- 7.2 Either school may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding at any time by giving a notice of termination in writing 6 months prior to the intended termination date; and
- 7.3 This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time by mutually written consents of both schools. The newly amended Memorandum must be signed by both parties.

8. Dispute Resolution

This Memorandum of Understanding is not a legally binding agreement, but only an expression and record of the intentions of the schools concerned. In signing this agreement, both schools sincerely pledge to honor the contents of this Memorandum of Understanding, with the fullest confidence that it will be carried out by both schools, with mutual loyalty and friendly cooperation.
